Where is the take-off point?

Take-off point is 1935 S. Campbell, Springfield, MO.

Can I come even if I'm not in the tournament?

Yes—all are welcome!

Can we shoot on the river that connects Table Rock and Bulls Shoals? (Lake Taneycomo)

No—this water is off limits.

Can I weigh in before the end of tournament hours Sunday morning?

Yes, we will start weighing fish at 4:00 am on Sunday, June 14.

What about Boating Safety Identification Card?

If you are fishing in Missouri: During tournament hours a Boating Safety Identification card is not required in Missouri. Outside tournament hours (pre-fishing, practice, etc...), a Boating Safety Identification card is required in Missouri. If you are fishing in Arkansas: Every person born after January 1, 1986, who operates a vessel on the lakes of this state, shall possess, on the vessel, a Boating Safety Identification card AT ALL TIME. A Boating Safety Identification card is required even during tournament hours. Both Arkansas and Missouri have reciprocal agreements with all states that issue Boating Safety Identification cards certified by NASBLA (National Association of Safe Boating Law Administrators).

What do we do with the fish?

Harvested fish are given to SF Organics in Illinois to make organic liquid fertilizer.

What are the Red Zones on Truman Lake?

The Corps of Engineers is creating a Red Zone map that will be available before the tournament.

How are you ensuring a level playing field?

Just like the past two years we will have Quality Assurance Testing (i.e. lie detector testing) at the tournament.

Why do I need \$100,000 in liability insurance to fish the tournament?

As with all major tournaments, \$100,000 in liability insurance is required to protect competitors, spectators, sponsors, and organizers. Failure to show proof of \$100,000 in liability insurance when requested will result in disqualification from the tournament and forfeiture of entry fee.

I have a fan boat, may I bring it to the tournament if I have a trolling motor?

Yes, you may bring your fan boat so long as "air power" is not used in scouting or competition. Any air/fan boat found using their propeller will be disqualified and reported to Water Patrol.

Can I use my Air/Fan Boat?

Yes—on Truman Lake only.

I am trying to pre-register for the tournament and there is only room for the captain, how do I sign up my team?

To make the registration process easier, only the team captain needs to pre-register. Print and complete the Official Entry and Release Form and enter all team member information clearly. Bring this to registration on June 12 or 13. All team members will receive a ticket for a chance to win the TRACKER® Sportsman's Package OR a Bad Boy Buggies UTV at tournament check-in, **if team captain pre-registration is received 72 hours prior to take off at 7pm, June 12th.**
